- Access is restricted by user ID and password, with stringent requirements for password security.
- Data is protected both at rest and in transit.
- Users of Jabra Xpress and Jabra Direct cannot access each other's data.
- Jabra solutions are fully compliant with GDPR.
- Data is anonymized to prevent tracing back to the source in the event of a leak, minimizing the risk of misuse.
- A dedicated process and department are in place to respond swiftly to any incidents.
