How do I change the wearing style on my BlueParrott S650-XT?

With your BlueParrott S650-XT headset you can:

- Wear the headset with the microphone on the left or right side
- Convert the headset to mono mode

Wear the headset with the microphone on the left or right side

The boom arm rotates 270 degrees to let you wear the headset with the microphone on the right or left side. Rotate the boom arm to the relevant side and position the flexible microphone one finger width from the corner of your mouth. Regardless of how you wear the headset, the Skip track forward button is always on the front of the earcup, and the Skip track back button is always on the back of earcup.

Convert the headset to mono mode

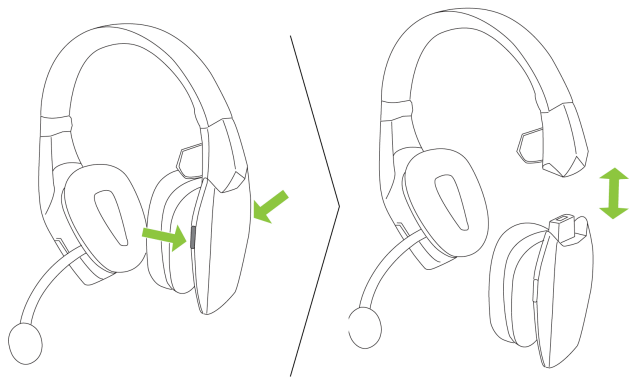
To convert your BlueParrott S650-XT headset from stereo to mono mode, press both release buttons on the earcup and firmly pull the earcup down to remove it from the headset. After removing the earcup, the headset is ready to be used.

Note

Every time you remove or attach the second earcup, the headset will reset to its default settings.

When in mono mode, the following applies:

- To achieve stereo mixing, Android users must ensure that the SBC audio codec is selected in the Developer options on their smartphone.
- Active Noise Cancellation (ANC) is still available on the headset.

**Note**

When the second earcup is not attached to the headset, it is recommended to store it in the carrying case.
